16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
17	SECTION 1. Section 60-6A-11.1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2011,
18	Chapter 109, Section 1) is amended to read:
19	"60-6A-11.1. DIRECT WINE SHIPMENT PERMITDIRECT BEER
20	SHIPMENT PERMITAUTHORIZATIONRESTRICTIONS
21	A. A licensee with a winegrower's or small brewer's
22	license or a person licensed in a state other than New Mexico
23	that holds a winery <u>or brewery</u> license may apply to the
24	director for and the director may issue to the applicant a
25	direct wine shipment permit or a direct beer shipment permit.

1 An application for a direct wine shipment permit or a direct 2 beer shipment permit shall include: 3 contact information for the applicant in a (1) 4 form required by the department; 5 (2)an annual application fee of fifty dollars (\$50.00) if the applicant does not hold a winegrower's or small 6 7 brewer's license; 8 the number of the applicant's winegrower's (3) 9 or small brewer's license if the applicant is located in New 10 Mexico or a copy of the applicant's winery or brewery license 11 if the applicant is located in a state other than New Mexico; 12 and 13 any other information or documents (4) 14 required by the director. Upon approval of an applicant for a 15 permit, the director shall forward to the taxation and revenue 16 department the name of each permittee and the contact information for the permittee. 17 18 Β. A direct wine shipment permit or a direct beer 19 shipment permit shall be valid for a permit year. A permittee 20 shall renew a direct wine shipment permit or a direct beer 21 shipment permit annually as required by the department to 22 continue making direct shipments of wine or beer to New Mexico 23 residents. 24 C. A permittee may ship: 25 (1) not more than two nine-liter cases of wine

1 or two twelve-quart cases of beer monthly to a New Mexico 2 resident who is twenty-one years of age or older for the 3 recipient's personal consumption or use, but not for resale; 4 and 5 (2) wine or beer directly to a New Mexico 6 resident only in containers that are conspicuously labeled with 7 the words: 8 "CONTAINS ALCOHOL 9 SIGNATURE OF PERSON 21 YEARS OR OLDER REQUIRED 10 FOR DELIVERY". 11 D. A permittee shall: 12 register with the taxation and revenue (1) 13 department for the payment of liquor excise tax and gross 14 receipts taxes due on the sales of wine or beer pursuant to the permittee's activities in New Mexico; 15 16 submit to the jurisdiction of New Mexico (2) 17 courts to resolve legal actions that arise from the shipping by 18 the permittee of wine or beer into New Mexico to New Mexico 19 residents; 20 monthly, by the twenty-fifth day of each (3) 21 month following the month in which the permittee was issued a 22 direct wine shipment permit or a direct beer shipment permit, 23 pay to the taxation and revenue department the liquor excise 24 tax due and the gross receipts tax due; and 25 (4) submit to an audit by an agent of the .224203.2 - 3 -

INTERSTATE WINE AND BEER TASTINGS --13 COMPETITIONS--PERMITS.--14 Exempt from the procurement of any other license Α. 15 or permit issued pursuant to the terms of the Liquor Control 16 Act, but not exempt from the procurement of a competition 17 permit, is a winemaker, [or] winery, brewer or brewery licensed 18 outside of New Mexico that desires to participate in a regional 19 wine, cider, beer or spirituous liquor tasting or competition 20 within New Mexico. One permit shall be issued by the director 21 to an out-of-state winemaker, [or] winery, brewer or brewery 22 for the duration of the wine or beer tasting or competition. 23 A person issued a competition permit pursuant to Β. 24 this section may do any of the following:
