AN ACT
RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLES; PROHIBITING DRIVING LESS THAN TEN MILES PER HOUR BELOW THE POSTED SPEED LIMIT IN THE FARTHEST LEFT LANE; PROVIDING PENALTIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
SECTION 1. Section 66-7-312 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1978, Chapter 35, Section 416) is amended to read:
"66-7-312. LIMITATIONS ON OVERTAKING ON THE LEFT.--
A. No vehicle shall be driven to the left side of the center of the roadway in overtaking and passing another vehicle proceeding in the same direction unless [sueh] the left side is clearly visible and free of oncoming traffic for a sufficient distance ahead to permit [sueh] the overtaking and passing to be completely made without interfering with the safe operation of any vehicle approaching from the opposite . 224786.1
direction or any vehicle overtaken. In every event, the overtaking vehicle must return to the right-hand side of the roadway before coming within one hundred feet of any vehicle approaching from the opposite direction.
B. A vehicle may not be driven in the farthest left lane of a multi-lane highway at a speed of less than ten miles per hour of the posted speed limit.
C. This section does not apply:
(1) when no other vehicle is directly behind the vehicle in the left lane;
(2) when traffic conditions and congestion make it impractical to drive in the right lane;
(3) when snow and other inclement weather conditions make it necessary to drive in the left lane;
(4) when obstructions or hazards exist in the right lane;
(5) when, because of highway design, a vehicle must be driven in the left lane when preparing to make a left turn or exit; or
(6) to law enforcement vehicles, ambulances and other emergency vehicles engaged in official duties and vehicles engaged in highway maintenance and construction operations.
D. A person who violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined one hundred dollars (\$100)." . 224786.1

SECTION 2. Section 66-8-116 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1978, Chapter 35, Section 524, as amended) is amended to read: "66-8-116. PENALTY ASSESSMENT MISDEMEANORS--DEFINITION-SCHEDULE OF ASSESSMENTS.--
A. B. The term "penalty assessment misdemeanor" does not include a violation that has caused or contributed to the cause of an accident resulting in injury or death to a person.
C. When an alleged violator of a penalty assessment misdemeanor elects to accept a notice to appear in lieu of a notice of penalty assessment, a fine imposed upon later conviction shall not exceed the penalty assessment established for the particular penalty assessment misdemeanor and probation imposed upon a suspended or deferred sentence shall not exceed ninety days.
D. The penalty assessment for speeding in violation . 224786.1
of Paragraph (5) of Subsection A of Section 66-7-301 NMSA 1978 is twice the penalty assessment established in Subsection A of this section for the equivalent miles per hour over the speed limit.
E. Upon a second conviction for operation without a permit for excessive size or weight pursuant to Section 66-7-413 NMSA 1978, the penalty assessment shall be two hundred fifty dollars (\$250). Upon a third or subsequent conviction, the penalty assessment shall be five hundred dollars (\$500).
F. Upon a second conviction for transport of a reducible load with a permit for excessive size or weight pursuant to Subsection $N$ of Section 66-7-413 NMSA 1978 more than six miles from a port-of-entry facility on the border with Mexico, the penalty assessment shall be five hundred dollars (\$500). Upon a third or subsequent conviction, the penalty assessment shall be one thousand dollars (\$1,000)."
