17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
18	SECTION 1. A new section of Chapter 21 NMSA 1978 is
19	enacted to read:

21	EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS AND INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS USED

A post-secondary educational institution shall not use or purchase any instructional materials for use within a classroom containing the term "Latinx" or "LatinX" when the term is used as an allencompassing term in reference to people of Hispanic descent."

SECTION 2. A new section of the Public School Code is enacted to read:

9 "[NEW MATERIAL] RESTRICTION OF LATINX IN SCHOOLS AND 10 INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS USED WITHIN THE CLASSROOM IN CERTAIN 11 CIRCUMSTANCES.--Beginning in the 2023-2024 school year, a 12 public school shall not allow the term "Latinx" or "LatinX" to 13 be used in any school setting, including after-school programs 14 offered by the school district, when the term is used as an 15 all-encompassing term in reference to people of Hispanic 16 descent. A public school shall not use or purchase any 17 instructional materials for use within a classroom containing 18 the term "Latinx" or "LatinX" when the term is used as an all-19 encompassing term in reference to people of Hispanic descent."
