| 15 | SECTION 1. [ <u>NEW MATERIAL</u> ] CYBERSECURITY FUNDCREATED   |
| 16 | PURPOSE  |
| 17 | A. The "cybersecurity fund" is created as a                    |
| 18 | nonreverting fund in the state treasury and shall be           |
| 19 | administered by the department of information technology for   |
| 20 | the purposes stated in Subsection B of this section; provided  |
| 21 | that upon Senate Bill 280 of the first session of the fifty-   |
| 22 | sixth legislature becoming law, the fund shall be administered |
| 23 | by the cybersecurity office. The fund consists of              |
| 24 | appropriations, bequests, distributions, donations, gifts,     |
| 25 | grants or money that otherwise accrues to the fund.            |
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Money in the cybersecurity fund shall be used Β. for cyber attack response and recovery services of information technology systems or databases operated or owned by any branch of state government, its political subdivisions, public schools or tribal entities.

C. Expenditures from the cybersecurity fund for cyber attack response and recovery services for:

executive state agencies, political (1)subdivisions of the state, public schools or tribal entities shall be made on warrants drawn by the secretary of finance and administration pursuant to vouchers signed by the secretary of 12 information technology; provided that upon Senate Bill 280 of the first session of fifty-sixth legislature becoming law, the vouchers shall be signed by the state chief information security officer;

legislative state agencies shall be made (2) on warrants drawn by the secretary of finance and administration pursuant to vouchers signed by the director of the legislative council service; and

judicial branch state agencies shall be (3) made on warrants drawn by the secretary of finance and administration pursuant to vouchers signed by the director of the administrative office of the courts.

SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION. -- Thirty-five million dollars (\$35,000,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the .223400.2 - 2 -
