BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. Section 13-6-4 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1979, Chapter 195, Section 5, as amended) is amended to read:

"13-6-4. DEFINITIONS.--As used in Chapter 13, Article 6 NMSA 1978:

- A. "local public body" means all political subdivisions, except <u>counties</u>, municipalities and school districts, of the state and their agencies, instrumentalities and institutions;
- B. "state agency" means the state of New Mexico or .225667.1
