AN ACT

RELATING TO THE PUBLIC PEACE, HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE;
PROHIBITING CERTAIN LOBBYING ACTIVITIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. A new section of the Lobbyist Regulation Act
is enacted to read:

"[NEW MATERIAL] PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES.--A lobbyist is
prohibited from:

A. directly or indirectly coercing or attempting to
coerce or threaten a legislator, legislative committee, public
officer or government employee to vote, take an official action
or perform any other governmental function that benefits the
lobbyist or the lobbyist's employer; or

B. offering any money, sexual favor or other thing
of value or promise of money, sexual favor or other thing of
