SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION.--Three million dollars 3 4 (\$3,000,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the 5 department of finance and administration for expenditure in 6 fiscal years 2023 through 2025 for Black fire recovery efforts; 7 provided that up to fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) of the 8 appropriated funds may be used for staff and related 9 administration costs for the efforts.
