19	<u>A.</u> Protected personal identifier information
20	contained in public records may be redacted by a public body
21	before inspection or copying of a record. The presence of
22	protected personal identifier information on a record does not
23	exempt the record from inspection. Unredacted records that
24	contain protected personal identifier information shall not be
25	made available on publicly accessible websites operated by or
