9	SECTION 1. A new section of the Motor Vehicle Code is

12	REGISTRATION PLATE	
13	A. The division shall issue a standardized	
14	concerns of police survivors, C.O.P.S., special registration	
15	plate with a logo designed pursuant to Section 66-3-424 NMSA	
16	1978 to recognize the families and friends of law enforcement	
17	officers killed in the line of duty.	
18	B. For an initial fee of forty-five dollars	
19	(\$45.00), which shall be in addition to the regular motor	
20	vehicle registration fees, the owner of a vehicle may apply	
21	for issuance of a concerns of police survivors, C.O.P.S.,	
22	special registration plate. The vehicle owner shall pay a	
23	renewal fee of thirty-five dollars (\$35.00) each year to	
24	retain and renew the concerns of police survivors, C.O.P.S.,

C. The revenue from the additional fee for a concerns of police survivors, C.O.P.S., special registration plate shall be distributed as follows:

(1) ten dollars (\$10.00) of the initial fee collected shall be retained by and is appropriated to the department to defray the cost of making and issuing the special registration plate with the concerns of police survivors, C.O.P.S., logo; and

9 (2) thirty-five dollars (\$35.00) of the 10 initial registration fee and the entire thirty-five dollars 11 (\$35.00) of subsequent renewal fees shall be distributed to 12 the law enforcement protection fund.

D. Beginning on July 1, 2026, and on July 1 of each subsequent year, the department shall compare the number of concerns of police survivors, C.O.P.S., special registration plates issued or registration renewals for those plates in the previous fiscal year with the average of the number of such plates issued in fiscal years 2024 and 2025.

E. By September 1 of a fiscal year in which the department determines that the number of concerns of police survivors, C.O.P.S., special registration plates issued or registration renewals for those plates in the previous fiscal year is less than fifty percent of the average number of such plates issued in fiscal years 2024 and 2025, the department shall stop issuing concerns of police survivors, C.O.P.S.,
