8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:		
9	SECTION 1. FIREFIGHTER RECRUITMENT FUND		
10	CREATEDRECRUITMENT STIPEND DISBURSEMENTREPORTING		
11	A. The "firefighter recruitment fund" is created		
12	in the state treasury. The fund consists of money		
13	appropriated by the legislature, federal money granted to the		
14	state for the purposes of the fund, income from investment of		
15	the fund and money otherwise accruing to the fund. Money in		
16	the fund is subject to appropriation by the legislature and		
17	shall not revert to any other fund at the end of a fiscal		
18	year. The homeland security and emergency management		
19	department shall administer the fund to provide:		
20	(1) a one-time five-thousand-dollar (\$5,000)		
21	recruitment disbursement for entry-level firefighters		
22	starting employment with a fire department for the first		
23	time; provided that the recipient remains employed as a		
24	firefighter with that fire department for three years; and		
25	(2) support for disbursement administration

B. The homeland security and emergency management department shall adopt and promulgate rules as necessary to implement the provisions of this section, including:

5 (1) a schedule for recruitment disbursement;6 and

7 (2) clawback or recapture rules that ensure
8 the repayment of recruitment disbursement funds that are
9 proportional to that portion of the three-year commitment
10 that has not been completed.

11 C. Money in the fund shall be disbursed on 12 warrants signed by the secretary of finance and 13 administration pursuant to vouchers signed by the secretary 14 of homeland security and emergency management or the 15 secretary's authorized representative.

16 D. The homeland security and emergency management department shall determine and distribute annually to a fire 17 department the amount necessary to provide a recruitment 18 disbursement to firefighters newly employed by that fire 19 20 department. A fire department shall expend funding received for no other purpose than that permitted by this section, and 21 any unexpended balance received by a fire department pursuant 22 to this section at the end of a fiscal year shall revert to 23 the firefighter recruitment fund. The homeland security and 24 25 emergency management department shall monitor the use of

2 recruitment fund.

E. To receive funding pursuant to Subsection D of this section, a fire department shall make a request to the homeland security and emergency management department prior to June 1 of each fiscal year.

F. The homeland security and emergency management
department shall submit an annual report providing
information collected pursuant to the rules adopted in
Subsection B of this section to the governor and the
legislative finance committee no later than December of each
year.

G. As used in this section:

(1) "fire department" means an organization of a county or municipality that employs firefighters and is entitled to distributions from the fire protection fund and is capable of providing fire suppression and related activities;

(2) "firefighter" means a person who is a full-time salaried public employee of a fire department, who provides fire suppression services involved in controlling and extinguishing fires and who is exposed to the dangers of heat, flame, smoke and other products of combustion, explosion or structural collapse; and

(3) "recruitment disbursement" means the
