

1 AN ACT

2 RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLES; PROVIDING THAT SPECIAL
3 REGISTRATION LOGOS SHALL BE MADE AS ATTACHABLE DECALS AND
4 STANDARDIZED SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATES SHALL BE MADE WITH A
5 BLANK SPACE TO ATTACH A LOGO; DEPLETING EXISTING MANUFACTURED
6 PLATES BEFORE CREATING ATTACHABLE LOGOS; REQUIRING THE MOTOR
7 VEHICLE DIVISION OF THE TAXATION AND REVENUE DEPARTMENT TO
8 APPLY FOR A LICENSE TO USE THE SMOKEY BEAR IMAGE AND NAME;
9 PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF A SMOKEY BEAR FIRE PREVENTION
10 SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

13 SECTION 1. Section 66-3-424 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2003,
14 Chapter 172, Section 1 and Laws 2003, Chapter 174, Section 1
15 and Laws 2003, Chapter 175, Section 1 and Laws 2003, Chapter
16 176, Section 1 and Laws 2003, Chapter 177, Section 1 and Laws
17 2003, Chapter 178, Section 1 and Laws 2003, Chapter 179,
18 Section 1 and Laws 2003, Chapter 180, Section 1 and Laws
19 2003, Chapter 181, Section 1 and Laws 2003, Chapter 197,
20 Section 1 and Laws 2003, Chapter 198, Section 1 and Laws
21 2003, Chapter 201, Section 1 and Laws 2003, Chapter 211,
22 Section 1 and also Laws 2003, Chapter 212, Section 1) is
23 amended to read:

24 "66-3-424. STANDARDIZED SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATES--
25 ATTACHABLE LOGOS.--

1 A. Standardized special registration plates with
2 logos may be authorized by statute to show state support for
3 worthy public purposes. The authorizing statute shall
4 provide for collection of fees that, at a minimum, will cover
5 the costs to the division of development, manufacture and
6 issuance of the special registration plates and logos. Logos
7 shall be made as attachable decals, and the standardized
8 special registration plates shall be made with a blank space
9 for a logo to be attached. For special registration plates
10 manufactured pursuant to this section before June 16, 2023,
11 any remaining supply of the manufactured plates shall be
12 depleted before developing and issuing attachable logos.

13 B. Standardized special registration plates, on
14 the standardized areas, shall:

15 (1) display the colors of the state flag,
16 red lettering on a yellow background;

17 (2) display the phrases "New Mexico USA" and
18 "Land of Enchantment";

19 (3) provide a space for applying the special
20 registration logo, centered at the left edge of the plate,
21 between the attachment holes, beginning one-fourth inch in
22 from the edge of the plate and having the following
23 dimensions: four and one-eighth inches in height and three
24 and one-eighth inches in width; and

25 (4) provide a vehicle registration number,

1 to be assigned by the division, that consists of five
2 alphanumeric characters displayed to the right of the special
3 logo area.

4 C. Special registration logos, except for the
5 standard dimension specified in Paragraph (3) of Subsection B
6 of this section, shall be left to the design discretion of
7 the division, in consultation with the public purpose
8 interest group that requests the special registration plate.

9 D. Standardized special registration plates with
10 logos, when authorized by statute for a particular public
11 purpose interest group, shall meet the requirements specified
12 in this subsection prior to plate issuance by the division.
13 The public purpose interest group, no later than the
14 effective date of the authorizing statute:

15 (1) shall provide evidence acceptable to the
16 division that it will generate a minimum number of prepaid
17 applications as determined by the division for the special
18 registration plate with logo;

19 (2) shall provide a prepayment to the
20 division in an amount sufficient to cover the plate and logo
21 cost of the initial order;

22 (3) shall provide a sample of the requested
23 artwork design in a format specified by the plate
24 manufacturer for the specialized logo; and

25 (4) in cases where the authorizing statute

1 includes revenue-sharing with distribution directed to a
2 particular group or fund, shall show that the recipient is a
3 governmental entity or a fund authorized for the use of a
4 governmental entity.

5 E. The division may promulgate rules for
6 implementation of the provisions of this section."

7 SECTION 2. A new section of the Motor Vehicle Code is
8 enacted to read:

9 "SPECIAL SMOKEY BEAR FIRE PREVENTION REGISTRATION
10 PLATE.--

11 A. The division shall apply for a long-term
12 license from the United States department of agriculture
13 forest service to use the image and name of Smokey Bear on a
14 standardized special registration plate to raise fire
15 prevention awareness and to raise money for state forest fire
16 prevention efforts.

17 B. Upon finalizing a license agreement pursuant to
18 Subsection A of this section, the division shall issue a
19 standardized Smokey Bear fire prevention special registration
20 plate with a logo designed pursuant to Section 66-3-424 NMSA
21 1978 indicating that the recipient supports forest fire
22 prevention awareness.

23 C. For an initial fee of fifty dollars (\$50.00),
24 which shall be in addition to the regular motor vehicle
25 registration fees, the owner of a vehicle may apply for

1 issuance of a Smokey Bear fire prevention awareness special
2 registration plate. The vehicle owner shall pay a renewal
3 fee of forty dollars (\$40.00) each year to retain and renew
4 the Smokey Bear forest fire prevention special registration
5 plate.

6 D. After payment for any licensing fee required
7 for the use of the Smokey Bear name or image, the revenue
8 from the additional fee for a Smokey Bear fire prevention
9 special registration plate shall be distributed as follows:

10 (1) ten dollars (\$10.00) of the initial fee
11 collected shall be retained by and is appropriated to the
12 department to defray the cost of making and issuing the
13 special registration plate with the Smokey Bear logo; and

14 (2) the remaining portion of the initial
15 registration fee and the entire portion of subsequent renewal
16 fees remaining after payment of licensing fees shall be
17 distributed to the energy, minerals and natural resources
18 department for forest fire prevention."

19 SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.--The effective date of the
20 provisions of this act is July 1, 2023. _____
