7	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:	
8	SECTION 1. It is proposed to amend Article 8, Section 5	
9	of the constitution of New Mexico to read:	
10	"A. The legislature shall exempt from taxation the	
11	property of each head of the family in the amount of two	
12	thousand dollars (\$2,000).	
13	B. The legislature shall exempt from taxation the	
14	property, including the community or joint property of	
15	married individuals, of every honorably discharged member of	
16	the armed forces of the United States and the widow or	
17	widower of every such honorably discharged member of the	
18	armed forces of the United States, in the sum of:	
19	(1) in 2006 and in each year through 2023,	
20	four thousand dollars (\$4,000);	
21	(2) in 2024, ten thousand dollars (\$10,000);	
22	and	
23	(3) in 2025 and each subsequent year, the	
24	amount provided in Paragraph (2) of this subsection, adjusted	
25	for inflation.	HJR 6 Page l

C. In every case where exemption is claimed on the ground of the claimant's having served with the armed forces of the United States pursuant to Subsection B of this section, the burden of proving actual and bona fide ownership of such property upon which exemption is claimed shall be upon the claimant."

SECTION 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be submitted to the people for their approval or rejection at the next general election or at any special election prior to that date that may be called for that purpose.

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
