5	WHEREAS, the United States national debt grew to a
6	record thirty-one trillion thirty-eight billion dollars
7	(\$31,038,000,000,000) in January 2023, as reported by the
8	United States department of the treasury; and
9	WHEREAS, national debt is the total amount of
10	outstanding borrowing by the federal government accumulated
11	through the nation's history; and
12	WHEREAS, the United States congress puts a limit on the
13	debt, which is known as the debt ceiling, and when this limit
14	is reached, the government must either raise or suspend the
15	ceiling to reduce the debt; and
16	WHEREAS, if the national debt gets too high, it could
17	impact Americans because spending on government programs may
18	be cut or people may have to pay higher taxes; and
19	WHEREAS, the national debt also impacts the economy when
20	it gets too high, and consumer and business confidence in the
21	economy may dwindle, which could lead to turmoil in the
22	financial markets and higher interest rates; and
23	WHEREAS, the United States congress is currently
24	considering ways to counter the continual growth of the
25	federal debt; and
