5	WHEREAS, the nation was founded on the belief that all
6	Americans live in a free society and are guaranteed the
7	inalienable rights of life, liberty and the pursuit of
8	happiness; and
9	WHEREAS, these freedoms everyone enjoys do not come
10	without a price, and they have been fought for and defended
11	by the nation's military service members who have sacrificed
12	to preserve and protect those freedoms and the country from
13	all enemies, foreign and domestic; and
14	WHEREAS, there exists in New Mexico a long and proud
15	history of military service by its residents, dating back to
16	the indigenous peoples who were willing to fight for, and
17	defend, their land from European settlers; and
18	WHEREAS, New Mexicans turned back the Confederacy at the
19	battle of Glorieta pass in northern New Mexico in 1862; and
20	WHEREAS, New Mexicans were an integral part of Teddy
21	Roosevelt's famed "rough riders", who helped drive off Spain
22	from Cuba and led to victory in the Spanish-American War; and
23	WHEREAS, in World War I, fourteen thousand one hundred
24	New Mexicans served; forty-nine thousand five hundred New
25	Mexicans served in World War II; twenty-five thousand New

HM 53 Page l Mexicans served in the Korean conflict; fifty-seven thousand New Mexicans served in the Vietnam conflict; and more than fifty thousand New Mexicans have served since the Gulf War; and

WHEREAS, with four military installations, twelve thousand seven hundred active-duty personnel, four thousand national guard and reserve members, as well as one hundred forty-one thousand veterans living in the state, military influence remains a strong part of the fabric of New Mexico today;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that recognition be extended to New Mexico's military personnel and veterans by declaring February 20, 2023 "Military and Veterans Day" in 14 15 the house of representatives; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that New Mexico's current and former military service members be honored and thanked for their service and sacrifice for the country; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this memorial be transmitted to the secretary-designate of veterans' services._ HM 53 Page 2
