FURNISHING OF REPORT TO DEPARTMENT.--9 10 A. As of January 1, 2014, a secondhand metal 11 dealer shall, not later than the second business day after the date of the purchase or other acquisition of regulated 12 material for which a record is required pursuant to Section 13 57-30-5 NMSA 1978, upload to the database maintained by the 14 15 department a report containing the information required to be recorded pursuant to that section. 16 A local governmental entity may impose 17 B. reporting requirements on secondhand metal dealers regarding 18 the purchase or acquisition of catalytic converters but not 19 20 other regulated material as long as the reporting requirements are no more stringent than the reporting requirements for 21 regulated material pursuant to the provisions of the Sale of 22 Recycled Metals Act."
