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AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL EXPENDITURES; REAUTHORIZING OR
REAPPROPRIATING BALANCES, EXPANDING OR CHANGING PURPOSES,
EXTENDING EXPENDITURE PERIODS, CHANGING AGENCIES, CLARIFYING
LOCATIONS AND ESTABLISHING CONDITIONS FOR THE REVERSION OR
TRANSFER OF UNEXPENDED BALANCES OF APPROPRIATIONS MADE BY THE
LEGISLATURE IN PRIOR YEARS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--REVERSION OF

PROCEEDS.--

A. Except as otherwise provided in another section
of this act:

(1) the unexpended balance from the proceeds
of severance tax bonds issued for a project that has been
reauthorized in this act shall revert to the severance tax
bonding fund:

(a) at the end of the expenditure
period as set forth in this act, if the expenditure period is
changed in this act; or

(b) if the expenditure period is not
changed in this act, pursuant to the time frame set forth in
the law that originally authorized the severance tax bonds or
the time frame set forth in any law that has previously
reauthorized the expenditure of the proceeds, whichever is

1 later; and

2 (2) all remaining balances from the proceeds
3 of severance tax bonds issued for a project that has been
4 reauthorized in this act shall revert to the severance tax
5 bonding fund three months after the reversion date for the
6 unexpended balances.

7 B. For the purpose of this section, "unexpended
8 balance" means the remainder of an appropriation after
9 reserving for unpaid costs and expenses covered by binding
10 written obligations to third parties.

11 SECTION 2. GENERAL FUND AND OTHER FUND APPROPRIATIONS--
12 REVERSIONS.--

13 A. Except as otherwise provided in another section
14 of this act:

15 (1) the unexpended balance of an
16 appropriation from the general fund or other state fund that
17 has been changed in this act shall revert:

18 (a) at the end of the expenditure
19 period as set forth in this act, if the expenditure period is
20 changed in this act; or

21 (b) if the expenditure period is not
22 changed in this act, pursuant to the time frame set forth in
23 the law in which the original appropriation was made or the
24 time frame set forth in any law that has previously changed
25 the appropriation, whichever is later; and

1 (2) all remaining balances of an
2 appropriation from the general fund or other state fund that
3 has been changed in this act shall revert three months after
4 the reversion date for the unexpended balance.

5 B. Except as provided in Subsection C of this
6 section, the balance of an appropriation made from the
7 general fund or other state fund shall revert pursuant to
8 Subsection A of this section to the originating fund.

9 C. The balance of an appropriation made from the
10 general fund or other state fund to the Indian affairs
11 department or the aging and long-term services department for
12 a project located on lands of an Indian nation, tribe or
13 pueblo shall revert pursuant to Subsection A of this section
14 to the tribal infrastructure project fund.

15 D. For the purpose of this section, "unexpended
16 balance" means the remainder of an appropriation after
17 reserving for unpaid costs and expenses covered by binding
18 written obligations to third parties.

19 SECTION 3. ACEQUIA DE LOS GARCIAS Y DURANES DAM
20 IMPROVEMENTS--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--The time of
21 expenditure for the interstate stream commission project in
22 Subsection 26 of Section 33 of Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 to
23 plan, design and construct diversion dam improvements for the
24 acequia de los Garcias y Duranes in the Medanales area in
25 Rio Arriba county is extended through fiscal year 2025.

1 SECTION 4. ACEQUIA DE ANTON CHICO, ACEQUIA DE
2 TECOLOTITO AND ACEQUIA DE LOS RANCHITOS IMPROVEMENT--EXTEND
3 TIME--GENERAL FUND.--The time of expenditure for the
4 interstate stream commission project in Subsection 15 of
5 Section 33 of Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 to plan, design and
6 construct improvements, including installation of pipe,
7 replacement of headgates and widening and reconstruction of
8 banks, to acequia de Anton Chico, acequia de Tecolotito and
9 acequia de los Ranchitos in Guadalupe and San Miguel counties
10 is extended through fiscal year 2025.

11 SECTION 5. PASEO DEL VOLCAN CONSTRUCTION IN BERNALILLO
12 AND SANDOVAL COUNTIES--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--The time
13 of expenditure for the department of transportation project
14 in Subsection 106 of Section 40 of Chapter 277 of Laws 2019
15 to acquire rights of way for and to plan, design and
16 construct paseo del Volcan, also known as New Mexico
17 highway 347, in Bernalillo and Sandoval counties is extended
18 through fiscal year 2025.

19 SECTION 6. ATRISCO DRIVE CONSTRUCTION--EXTEND TIME--
20 GENERAL FUND.--The time of expenditure for the department of
21 transportation project in Subsection 5 of Section 40 of
22 Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 to acquire rights of way and to
23 plan, design and construct a road, including drainage,
24 off Atrisco drive between Rosendo Garcia road and
25 San Ygnacio road in Bernalillo county is extended through

1 fiscal year 2025.

2 SECTION 7. ALBUQUERQUE ENCUENTRO CENTER RENOVATION--
3 CHANGE TO PURCHASE, RENOVATE AND INSTALL A MODULAR BUILDING--
4 SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The unexpended balance of the
5 appropriation to the local government division in
6 Subsection 43 of Section 29 of Chapter 138 of Laws 2021 to
7 plan, design, construct, renovate and equip an educational
8 and service facility in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county
9 shall not be expended for the original purpose but is
10 changed to plan, design, construct, purchase, deliver,
11 renovate, furnish, equip and install a modular building
12 for an education and workforce development center in
13 Bernalillo county.

14 SECTION 8. ALBUQUERQUE ENCUENTRO CENTER RENOVATION--
15 CHANGE TO PURCHASE, RENOVATE AND INSTALL A MODULAR BUILDING--
16 SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The unexpended balance of the
17 appropriation to the local government division in
18 Subsection 60 of Section 30 of Chapter 53 of Laws 2022 to
19 plan, design, construct, renovate, equip and furnish an
20 education and workforce development center for low-income
21 Spanish speakers in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county shall
22 not be expended for the original purpose but is changed
23 to plan, design, construct, purchase, deliver, renovate,
24 furnish, equip and install a modular building for an
25 education and workforce development center in

1 Bernalillo county.

2 SECTION 9. BERNALILLO COUNTY FAMILY SERVICES FACILITIES
3 CONSTRUCTION--CHANGE TO RENOVATE A FAMILY SERVICES FACILITY--
4 SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The unexpended balance of the
5 appropriation to the local government division in
6 Subsection 4 of Section 29 of Chapter 138 of Laws 2021 to
7 demolish an existing building and to plan, design and
8 construct a child development and family services facility in
9 the south valley in Bernalillo county shall not be expended
10 for the original purpose but is changed to plan, design,
11 construct, renovate, furnish, equip and landscape a family
12 services facility in the south valley in Bernalillo county.

13 SECTION 10. BERNALILLO COUNTY FAMILY SERVICES
14 FACILITIES CONSTRUCTION--CHANGE TO RENOVATE FACILITY--
15 SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The unexpended balance of the
16 appropriation to the local government division in
17 Subsection 12 of Section 30 of Chapter 53 of Laws 2022 to
18 demolish an existing building and to plan, design and
19 construct a child development and family services facility in
20 the south valley in Bernalillo county shall not be expended
21 for the original purpose but is changed to plan, design,
22 construct, renovate, furnish, equip and landscape a child
23 development and family services facility in the south valley
24 in Bernalillo county.

25 SECTION 11. ALBUQUERQUE NATIONAL FLAMENCO INSTITUTE

1 EQUIPMENT PURCHASE--CHANGE TO IMPROVE BERNALILLO COUNTY
2 FLAMENCO FACILITY--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The
3 unexpended balance of the appropriation to the local
4 government division in Subsection 97 of Section 30 of
5 Chapter 53 of Laws 2022 to equip and furnish education and
6 performance spaces, sound and lighting, storage and video
7 computer technology for performance capture and archives for
8 the national institute of Flamenco arts and education in
9 Albuquerque in Bernalillo county shall not be expended for
10 the original purpose but is changed to purchase equipment,
11 appliances and information technology and to plan, design,
12 construct, purchase, furnish, equip and improve buildings,
13 infrastructure and outdoor education, arts and performance
14 spaces at a flamenco facility in Bernalillo county. The time
15 of expenditure is extended through fiscal year 2025.

16 SECTION 12. ALBUQUERQUE NATIONAL INSTITUTE OF FLAMENCO
17 IMPROVEMENTS--CHANGE TO IMPROVE BERNALILLO COUNTY FLAMENCO
18 BUILDING AND PERFORMANCE SPACES--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The
19 unexpended balance of the appropriation to the local
20 government division in Subsection 75 of Section 29 of
21 Chapter 138 of Laws 2021 to plan, design, construct, improve,
22 equip and furnish buildings and infrastructure, including a
23 café, reception space, studio, outdoor area, information
24 technology, audio equipment and furniture, at a flamenco
25 studio in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county shall not be

1 expended for the original purpose but is changed to purchase
2 equipment, appliances and information technology and to plan,
3 design, construct, purchase, furnish, equip and improve
4 buildings, infrastructure and outdoor education, arts
5 and performance spaces at a flamenco facility in
6 Bernalillo county.

7 SECTION 13. ALBUQUERQUE MEAL DELIVERY PROGRAM EQUIPMENT
8 PURCHASE--CHANGE TO PURCHASE BERNALILLO COUNTY MEAL DELIVERY
9 PROGRAM EQUIPMENT--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The unexpended
10 balance of the appropriation to the local government division
11 in Subsection 68 of Section 29 of Chapter 138 of Laws 2021 to
12 purchase and install equipment, including freezers, ovens, a
13 blast chiller, information technology and related equipment
14 and infrastructure, for a homebound and special needs meal
15 delivery program in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county shall
16 not be expended for the original purpose but is changed to
17 purchase and install equipment, including information
18 technology and related equipment and infrastructure, cooking
19 equipment, white goods, appliances and storage equipment, for
20 a homebound and special needs meal delivery program in
21 Bernalillo county.

22 SECTION 14. BERNALILLO COUNTY MOUNTAINVIEW SIDEWALKS
23 AND DRAINAGE INFRASTRUCTURE--EXPAND PURPOSE--EXTEND TIME--
24 GENERAL FUND.--The department of transportation project in
25 Subsection 7 of Section 40 of Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 to

1 plan, design and construct sidewalks and drainage
2 infrastructure in the Mountainview area, including
3 Prince street and Prosperity avenue, in Bernalillo county may
4 include the acquisition of rights of way. The time of
5 expenditure is extended through fiscal year 2025.

6 SECTION 15. SOUTH VALLEY FAMILY SERVICES BUILDINGS
7 REDEVELOPMENT--CHANGE TO RENOVATE A SOUTH VALLEY FAMILY
8 SERVICES FACILITY--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--The unexpended
9 balance of the appropriation to the local government division
10 in Subsection 22 of Section 34 of Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 to
11 plan, design, demolish and construct a phased development and
12 replacement of buildings and facilities for a family services
13 program in the south valley in Bernalillo county shall not be
14 expended for the original purpose but is changed to plan,
15 design, construct, renovate, furnish, equip and landscape a
16 family services facility in the south valley. The time
17 of expenditure for the project is extended through fiscal
18 year 2025.

19 SECTION 16. BERNALILLO COUNTY STREET LIGHTS
20 DISTRICT 2--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--The time of
21 expenditure for the department of transportation project in
22 Subsection 8 of Section 40 of Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 to
23 plan, design, construct and install street lights in
24 county commission district 2 in Bernalillo county is extended
25 through fiscal year 2025.

1 SECTION 17. BERNALILLO COUNTY WEST CENTRAL FIRE STATION
2 CONSTRUCTION--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--The time of
3 expenditure for the local government division project in
4 Subsection 15 of Section 34 of Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 to
5 acquire land for and to plan, design, construct and equip a
6 fire station on the west side of Bernalillo county is
7 extended through fiscal year 2025.

8 SECTION 18. BERNALILLO COUNTY WHISPERING PINES SENIOR
9 MEAL SITE VEHICLE PURCHASE--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--The
10 time of expenditure for the aging and long-term services
11 department project in Subsection 1 of Section 4 of
12 Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 to purchase and equip a meal
13 delivery vehicle and to make improvements to the facility at
14 the Whispering Pines senior meal site in Bernalillo county is
15 extended through fiscal year 2025.

16 SECTION 19. BRIDGE BOULEVARD PHASE 2 BUS SHELTERS AND
17 MEDIAN ART IMPROVEMENTS--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--The time
18 of expenditure for the department of transportation project
19 in Subsection 9 of Section 40 of Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 to
20 plan, design and construct phase 2 improvements, including
21 bus shelters and median art, along Bridge boulevard between
22 Young avenue and the Riverside drain in the south valley in
23 Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal year 2025.

24 SECTION 20. DENNIS CHAVEZ BOULEVARD AND
25 CONDESHIRE DRIVE SW INTERSECTION STREET LIGHTS--CLARIFYING

1 LOCATION--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The location for
2 the department of transportation project in Subsection 10
3 of Section 38 of Chapter 81 of Laws 2020 to plan,
4 design, construct, equip and install street lights at
5 the intersection of Dennis Chavez boulevard and
6 Condershire drive SW in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county is
7 Bernalillo county. The time of expenditure is extended
8 through fiscal year 2025.

9 SECTION 21. ESCARPMENT ROAD PAVING AND IMPROVEMENT--
10 EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--The time of expenditure for the
11 department of transportation project in Subsection 10 of
12 Section 40 of Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 to plan, design and
13 construct paving and other improvements on Escarpment road on
14 the southwest mesa in Bernalillo county is extended through
15 fiscal year 2025.

16 SECTION 22. ISLETA BOULEVARD REHABILITATION--EXTEND
17 TIME--GENERAL FUND.--The time of expenditure for the
18 department of transportation project in Subsection 12 of
19 Section 40 of Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 to plan, design and
20 construct the rehabilitation of Isleta boulevard SW from
21 Muniz road to interstate highway 25 in Bernalillo county is
22 extended through fiscal year 2025.

23 SECTION 23. MOONLIGHT DRIVE PUEBLO OF ISLETA
24 EXTENSION--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--The time of
25 expenditure for the department of transportation project in

1 Subsection 39 of Section 40 of Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 to
2 plan, design, construct and extend Moonlight drive,
3 including arroyo stabilization and a retention pond, in the
4 Pueblo of Isleta in Bernalillo county is extended through
5 fiscal year 2025.

6 SECTION 24. NEW MEXICO HIGHWAY 333 AND TABLAZON ROAD
7 INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--The
8 time of expenditure for the department of transportation
9 project in Subsection 15 of Section 40 of Chapter 277 of
10 Laws 2019 to acquire rights of way for and to plan,
11 design and construct improvements at the intersection of
12 Tablazon road and New Mexico highway 333, including
13 realignment and road extension, in Bernalillo county is
14 extended through fiscal year 2025.

15 SECTION 25. NEW MEXICO HIGHWAYS 314, 45 AND 317
16 REALIGNMENT PROJECT--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--The time of
17 expenditure for the department of transportation project in
18 Subsection 14 of Section 40 of Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 to
19 plan, design and construct the New Mexico highways 314, 45
20 and 317 realignment project to comply with road safety audit
21 recommendations in the Pueblo of Isleta in Bernalillo county
22 is extended through fiscal year 2025.

23 SECTION 26. SOUTH VALLEY DITCH ACCESS GATES
24 IMPROVEMENTS--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of
25 expenditure for the interstate stream commission project

1 originally authorized in Subsection 1 of Section 34 of
2 Chapter 81 of Laws 2020 and reauthorized to the local
3 government division in Laws 2021, Chapter 139, Section 8 to
4 purchase, deliver and install materials and equipment and to
5 plan, design, construct, improve and equip existing and new
6 access control gates for ditches and acequias in the
7 south valley area of Bernalillo county is extended through
8 fiscal year 2025.

9 SECTION 27. SOUTH VALLEY DITCH CONTROL ACCESS GATES
10 EQUIPMENT AND IMPROVEMENTS--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--The
11 time of expenditure for the project originally appropriated
12 to the local government division in Subsection 20 of
13 Section 34 of Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 and reauthorized in
14 Laws 2021, Chapter 139, Section 9 to purchase, deliver and
15 install materials and equipment and to plan, design,
16 construct, improve and equip existing and new access control
17 gates for ditches and acequias in the south valley area of
18 Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal year 2025.

19 SECTION 28. SECOND STREET SOUTHWEST ROAD AND DRAIN
20 IMPROVEMENTS--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--The time of
21 expenditure for the department of transportation project in
22 Subsection 3 of Section 40 of Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 to
23 plan, design and construct phase 2 improvements, including
24 drainage, sidewalk and improvements to comply with the
25 federal Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, to

1 Second street SW in Bernalillo county is extended through
2 fiscal year 2025.

3 SECTION 29. FOURTH STREET NW IMPROVEMENTS--EXPAND
4 PURPOSE--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--The department of
5 transportation project in Subsection 18 of Section 40 of
6 Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 to plan, design and construct
7 improvements, including sidewalk infill, accessibility
8 features and demolition of retaining walls, on
9 Fourth street NW in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county may
10 include the acquisition of rights of way. The time of
11 expenditure is extended through fiscal year 2025.

12 SECTION 30. FOURTH STREET SW IMPROVEMENTS--CHANGE TO
13 ACQUIRE RIGHTS OF WAY AND TO IMPROVE FOURTH STREET SW AND
14 SIDEWALKS--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--The unexpended balance
15 of the appropriation to the department of transportation in
16 Subsection 19 of Section 40 of Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 to
17 plan, design and construct street and sidewalk improvements
18 on Fourth street SW in the Barelas neighborhood of
19 Albuquerque in Bernalillo county shall not be expended for
20 the original purpose but is changed to acquire rights of way
21 and to plan, design and construct street and sidewalk
22 improvements, including sidewalk infill, accessibility
23 features and demolition of retaining walls, on
24 Fourth street SW in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county. The
25 time of expenditure is extended through fiscal year 2025.

1 SECTION 31. ALBUQUERQUE WEST SIDE SPORTS COMPLEX
2 CONSTRUCTION--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--The time of
3 expenditure for the local government division project in
4 Subsection 121 of Section 34 of Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 to
5 acquire land and rights of way for and to plan, design,
6 construct, furnish and equip an indoor sports complex in the
7 west side area of Albuquerque in Bernalillo county is
8 extended through fiscal year 2025.

9 SECTION 32. ALBUQUERQUE DAY SHELTER AND BEHAVIORAL
10 HEALTH SERVICES CENTER PURCHASE AND CONSTRUCTION--CHANGE
11 TO CONSTRUCT A DAY SHELTER AND HEALTH CENTER IN THE
12 GIBSON HEALTH HUB--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--The unexpended
13 balance of the appropriation to the local government division
14 in Subsection 45 of Section 34 of Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 to
15 plan, design, purchase and construct a day shelter and
16 behavioral health services center in Albuquerque in
17 Bernalillo county shall not be expended for the original
18 purpose but is changed to plan, design, purchase, construct,
19 equip and furnish a day shelter and behavioral health
20 services center in the Gibson health hub in Albuquerque. The
21 time of expenditure is extended through fiscal year 2025.

22 SECTION 33. ALBUQUERQUE EMERGENCY FOOD DISTRIBUTION
23 PROGRAM PURCHASE OF VEHICLES AND EQUIPMENT--EXTEND TIME--
24 SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of expenditure for the local
25 government division project in Subsection 42 of Section 29 of

1 Chapter 138 of Laws 2021 to purchase vehicles and equipment
2 for use by a food bank emergency food distribution program
3 in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county is extended through
4 fiscal year 2025.

5 SECTION 34. ALBUQUERQUE FIRE DEPARTMENT VEHICLE
6 PURCHASE--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of
7 expenditure for the local government division project in
8 Subsection 50 of Section 29 of Chapter 138 of Laws 2021 to
9 purchase and equip fire department vehicles for Albuquerque
10 in Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal year 2025.

11 SECTION 35. ALBUQUERQUE FIRE STATION 23 CONSTRUCTION--
12 CHANGE TO CONSTRUCT A FIRE STATION--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The
13 unexpended balance of the appropriation to the local
14 government division in Subsection 49 of Section 29 of
15 Chapter 138 of Laws 2021 to plan, design and construct
16 fire station 23 on the northwest mesa in Albuquerque in
17 Bernalillo county shall not be expended for the original
18 purpose but is changed to plan, design and construct a
19 fire station on the northwest mesa in Albuquerque in
20 Bernalillo county.

21 SECTION 36. ALBUQUERQUE FOOD BUSINESS INCUBATOR AND
22 KITCHEN CONSTRUCTION--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--The time of
23 expenditure for the local government division project in
24 Subsection 63 of Section 34 of Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 to
25 acquire land for and to plan, design, construct, furnish,

1 equip and install equipment for a commercial kitchen and
2 food business incubator in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county
3 is extended through fiscal year 2025.

4 SECTION 37. ALBUQUERQUE HOLOCAUST AND INTOLERANCE
5 MUSEUM--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--The time of expenditure
6 for the local government division project in Subsection 66 of
7 Section 34 of Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 to plan, design,
8 construct and renovate a facility for the Holocaust and
9 Intolerance museum in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county is
10 extended through fiscal year 2025.

11 SECTION 38. ALBUQUERQUE ASIAN AND PACIFIC ISLANDER
12 COMMUNITY CENTER CONSTRUCTION--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--
13 The time of expenditure for the local government division
14 project originally authorized in Subsection 31 of Section 34
15 of Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 and reauthorized in Laws 2020,
16 Chapter 82, Section 12 to plan, design and construct a
17 city-owned community center inclusive of the cultural needs
18 of the Asian and Pacific Islander population in Albuquerque
19 in Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal year 2025.

20 SECTION 39. ALBUQUERQUE ROUTE 66 SIGNAGE CONSTRUCTION--
21 EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--The time of expenditure for the
22 local government division project in Subsection 107 of
23 Section 34 of Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 to plan, design,
24 construct and install route 66 signage at the Central avenue
25 and Lomas boulevard intersection area in Albuquerque in

1 Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal year 2025.

19 including the purchase of sludge dewatering equipment, in
20 Bayard in Grant county is extended through fiscal year 2025.

21 SECTION 304. TAYLOR-BARELA-REYNOLDS-MESILLA HISTORIC

22 SITE IMPROVEMENT--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--The time of
23 expenditure for the cultural affairs department project in
24 Subsection 6 of Section 9 of Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 to
25 plan, design, construct, repair, renovate, equip and make

1 improvements to facilities and exhibits, including site
2 improvements, to the Taylor-Barela-Reynolds-Mesilla historic
3 site in Dona Ana county is extended through fiscal year 2025.

6 IMPROVEMENT--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--The time of
7 expenditure for the board of regents of eastern
8 New Mexico university project in Subsection 1 of Section 42
9 of Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 to plan, design, construct and
10 equip an electrical supply line and related electrical
11 infrastructure improvements at the Roswell branch campus of
12 eastern New Mexico university in Chaves county is extended
13 through fiscal year 2025.

14 SECTION 306. POJOAQUE FIRE STATION TWO CONSTRUCTION--
15 CHANGE TO IMPROVE FIRE STATIONS IN THE POJOAQUE FIRE
16 DISTRICT--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--The unexpended balance
17 of the appropriation to the local government division in
18 Subsection 393 of Section 34 of Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 to
19 plan, design, construct, furnish and equip Pojoaque
20 fire station two in the area of Jacona and El Rancho in
21 Santa Fe county shall not be expended for the original
