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5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
6	SECTION 1. Section 8-1-1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1971,
7	Chapter 260, Section 1, as amended) is amended to read:
8	"8-1-1. COMPENSATION OF ELECTIVE STATE OFFICERS
9	A. Annual compensation of elective state officers
10	shall be paid as follows:
11	governor
12	lieutenant governor 144,714
13	secretary of state 144,714
14	state auditor 144,714
15	state treasurer 144,714
16	attorney general
17	commissioner of public lands 149,714.
18	B. Any person succeeding to the office of governor
19	as provided in Article 5, Section 7 of the constitution of
20	New Mexico shall receive the salary of the office. Every
21	person serving as acting governor during the incapacity or
22	absence of the governor from the state, shall receive five
23	hundred dollars (\$500) as compensation for each day's service
24	as acting governor.

C. All compensation under this section shall be

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1	paid from the general fund, except that the amount paid to
2	the commissioner of public lands shall be paid from the state
3	lands maintenance fund."
4	SECTION 2. REPEALSection 8-3-3 NMSA 1978 (being
5	Laws 1971, Chapter 138, Section 3, as amended) is repealed.
6	SECTION 3. APPLICABILITYThe provisions of this act
7	relating to the annual compensation set for the governor apply
8	to that position for terms of office beginning on or after
9	January 1, 2027
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
