SUMMARY

Synopsis of House Bill 1.

House Bill 1 appropriates \$11.7 million from the general fund for legislative session expenses and \$45.7 million from the general fund and cash balances to various agencies interim expenses, including fiscal year (FY) 2024 operating budgets of the Legislative Council Service, Legislative Finance Committee, Legislative Education Study Committee, and House and Senate chief clerk offices. Other appropriations include legislative interim expenses, session preparation, statewide legislative internship program, expenses of the Senate Rules Committee, legislative information system, legislative dues, legislative processing system, chamber display boards, a study of legislator district staff offices, constituent services platform, and the markup language database.

The bill includes an emergency clause to take effect immediately upon signature by the governor.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The bill appropriates \$11.7 million to fund the expenses of the First Session of the Fifty-Sixth Legislature and other legislative expenses. The bill appropriates \$400 thousand from cash

balances for the legislative department's share of costs for the master database of official annotated laws of the state, markup language and tagging its use for legislative document systems for expenditure in FY23 and FY24. The bill includes \$21.9 million from the general fund for recurring expenses for the legislative offices, \$5.7 million for other interim expenses, and \$2.1 million from the general fund for the legislative information system for expenditure in FY23 and FY24. The bill also includes nonrecurring general fund appropriations for a legislative processing system (\$9.5 million) and audiovisual upgrades for committee hearing rooms (\$1.5 million), constituent services platform (\$500 thousand), House/Senate chamber display boards (\$1.3 million), and a legislator district staff offices study (\$2.5 million).
