11	DECLARING JANUARY 31, 2023 "DEMING LUNA COUNTY SILVER SPIKES
12	DAY" IN THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

14	WHEREAS, in the mid-1970s, several business people from
15	the city of Deming and Luna county formed a local nonpartisan
16	group to greet prospective new businesses and industries and
17	visiting dignitaries; and
18	WHEREAS, the small rural community area benefited from the
19	opportunities provided by the organization; and
20	WHEREAS, the name "silver spikes" comes from the ceremony
21	held when, in March 1881, a silver spike was driven into the
22	railroad at Deming to mark the completion of the second
23	transcontinental railroad, which united the Santa Fe and
24	Southern Pacific railroads; and
25	WHEREAS, with the completion of the railroad, Deming and

Luna county began to experience growth; and

WHEREAS, Deming has always been known for its hospitality, beginning with its famous Harvey house restaurant and Harvey girls, making Deming a must-stop for rail travelers; and

WHEREAS, the Harvey girls were Deming's predecessors to the Deming Luna county silver spikes; and

WHEREAS, the Deming Luna county silver spikes members were called upon to greet new members of the community; and

WHEREAS, in the 1980s, the community leaders realized the Deming Luna county silver spikes could serve a valuable role by visiting Santa Fe each year during the legislative session and meeting with the governor and select department officials to discuss the area's local needs; and

WHEREAS, also during the 1980s, the benefit of bringing together elected officials and administrators of Deming, the village of Columbus and Luna county school districts to express their needs was recognized; and

WHEREAS, during the legislative session, a large reception is held one evening for invited guests; and

WHEREAS, the Deming Luna county silver spikes have provided a valuable venue to promote the needs of the area and assist with the creation of new businesses and industries;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that January 31, 2023 be declared "Deming Luna County Silver Spikes Day" in the .224408.2
