A MEMORIAL

DECLARING FEBRUARY 13, 2023 "NEW MEXICO STATE UNIVERSITY AGGIES  
FOOTBALL TEAM DAY" IN THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

WHEREAS, the New Mexico state university aggies football  
team finished the 2022 regular season with a record of six wins  
and six losses; and

WHEREAS, the aggies were invited to play in the Quick Lane  
bowl at Ford field in Detroit, Michigan, on December 26, 2022,  
their fifth bowl game in school history; and

WHEREAS, the aggies ended a historic season in Michigan  
with a twenty-four to nineteen victory over Bowling Green state  
university in the Quick Lane bowl game; and

WHEREAS, the nationally televised game drew more than two  
million three hundred thousand viewers from across the country;  
and

1           WHEREAS, the aggies were led by quarterback and  
2 Albuquerque native Diego Pavia, who accumulated one hundred  
3 sixty-seven passing yards and an additional sixty-five rushing  
4 yards and was named the most valuable player of the Quick Lane  
5 bowl; and

6           WHEREAS, Trevor Brohard, a linebacker from Los Lunas,  
7 recorded three tackles and an interception in his final game  
8 for the crimson and white; and

9           WHEREAS, Shiyazh Pete, an offensive lineman from Shiprock  
10 high school, led the way for the aggie offensive line, allowing  
11 for four hundred seven yards of total offense in the bowl game;  
12 and

13           WHEREAS, New Mexico state university head football coach  
14 Jerry Kill led the aggies to seven wins in his first season as  
15 the aggies head coach, just the third season with seven or more  
16 wins for the aggies since 1968;

17           NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF  
18 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the New Mexico  
19 state university aggies football team be congratulated for its  
20 victory over Bowling Green state university at the 2022 Quick  
21 Lane bowl; and

22           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that February 13, 2023 be  
23 proclaimed "New Mexico State University Aggies Football Team  
24 Day" in the house of representatives; and

25           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this memorial be
