14	WHEREAS, New Mexico has always supported its military
15	veteran population; and
16	WHEREAS, the purple heart medal is the oldest military
17	decoration in present use and was initially created as the
18	badge of military merit by General George Washington in 1782;

20	WHEREAS, the purple heart medal was the first American
21	service award or decoration made available to the common
22	soldier and is specifically awarded to members of the United
23	States armed forces who have been wounded or made the ultimate
24	sacrifice in combat with a declared enemy of the United States

WHEREAS, the mission of the military order of the purple heart is to foster an environment of goodwill among combatwounded veteran members and their families, promote patriotism, support legislative initiatives and, most importantly, ensure that purple heart recipients are never forgotten; and

WHEREAS, an estimated two thousand five hundred to three thousand New Mexicans have earned the purple heart medal; and

WHEREAS, the sacrifices that New Mexico purple heart recipients have made in defending residents' freedoms are acknowledged and appreciated; and

WHEREAS, it is important that purple heart recipients be acknowledged for their courage and shown the honor and support they earned;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that New Mexico be declared a purple heart state and that purple heart recipients be honored and recognized for their service and sacrifice for the state and the United States; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be transmitted to the secretary of veterans' services and the department of New Mexico military order of the purple heart.
