22	WHEREAS, support groups are led by peers who have
23	experience in suicide issues and who have been trained to
24	facilitate; and
25	WHEREAS, survivors of suicide meetings are attended by

WHEREAS, meetings are also frequently attended by mental health professionals who offer various perspectives on unexpected death, grief and bereavement, guilt, responsibility and mourning; and

9 for survivors and to speak out about mental health issues and
10 suicide; and

WHEREAS, survivors of suicide volunteers are dedicated to providing information and support to assist in the grieving and healing process;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that February 22, 2023 be declared "Survivors of Suicide Day" in the legislature; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this memorial be transmitted to survivors of suicide.
