#### **SECTION III: NARRATIVE**

#### **BILL SUMMARY**

Synopsis: This bill amends Section 26-2C-27 NMSA 1978, "Personal Production of Cannabis – Penalties –"; Section 26-2C-28, "Unlicensed Sales of Cannabis – Penalties –"; and Section 26-2C-30, "Unlawful Possession of Cannabis – Penalties –" of the Cannabis Regulation Act (CRA). The bill also amends Section 32A-2-3 NMSA 1978, "Definitions" of the Delinquency Act.

The proposed amendments to Section 27 of the CRA, removes specific penalties for juveniles under the age of 18 who intentionally produce cannabis. The amendment to Section 28 of the CRA adds a reference to the Delinquency Act to add penalties to juveniles found to be engaging in unlawful cannabis activities. The proposed amendment to Section 30 of the CRA change the age range for unlawful possession of cannabis from "under the age of 21", to "18 – 21" years of age.

The proposed amendments to the Delinquency Act add definitions related to cannabis including cannabis, cannabis extracts, and cannabis products. Proposed amendments also add engaging in commercial cannabis activity as a delinquent act.
