BILL SUMMARY

Synopsis: HB 126 appropriates a one-time \$800,000 from the general fund to the public school facilities authority to conduct a statewide public school ventilation verification assessment in the fiscal year 2025. The assessment shall conform with the consensus-based, code enforceable building standards for reducing the risk of transmission through exposure to infectious aerosols and the federal centers for disease control and prevention "ventilation in buildings" performance guidelines. Any unencumbered balance shall revert back to the general fund at the end of the fiscal year.
