BILL SUMMARY

<u>Synopsis</u>: Relating to Education. Creating the Tribal Education Trust Fund (TETF), providing reporting requirements, and making an appropriation.

FIR is in response to Amendments to Bill, which modify the Tribal Disbursement Formula Task Force creation language.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

Creation of the Tribal Education Trust Fund and Distribution of Funds from the TETF proposes providing funding to NM Nations Tribes and Pueblos (NPTs) for purposes enumerated in the Indian education Act, NMSA 1978 §22-23A-2.

Amendment modifies the Task Force creation, proposing that the Legislative Education Study Committee work with tribal representatives to propose an equitable tribal representation to the Task Force membership. It proposes that the with Indian Affairs Secretary may participate in the deliberations with tribal representatives in an advisory capacity. Task force membership recommendations shall be presented to LESC no later than Sept. 1, 2024.

PERFORMANCE IMPLICATIONS

PED will be responsible for reporting and distribution of funds.

ADMINISTRATIVE IMPLICATIONS

PED will be responsible for any administrative functions and fund distributions through Intergovernmental Agreements between PED and NPTs.
