BILL SUMMARY

House Bill 180 (HB180) appropriates \$100,000.00 from the general fund to the Department of Health to develop a pregnancy and parenting resource website and hotline to provide resources to expectant families and new parents.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The appropriation goes directly to the Department of Health. No appropriation is made to the Early Childhood Education and Care Department (ECECD).

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

The Department of Health currently operates a reproductive health hotline (1-833-796-8773). There is not a hotline specifically for expectant families or new parents at the Department of Health. However, ECECD does provide pregnancy and parenting resources through the ECECD's website and through several programs that serve expecting parents and new parents, including Home Visiting, Early Intervention (FIT), and Families FIRST nurse case management, as well as an 800 number for questions on prenatal to five services.
