BILL SUMMARY

<u>Synopsis:</u> HB 229 proposes to amend sections of the Public School Code by providing certain specialized support services ancillary to special education, including medical, behavioral health or adaptive physical education services; providing that school districts and charter schools include specialized support services in department-approved educational plans.

OTHER SUBSTANTIVE ISSUES

The Medicaid School-Based Services (MSBS) Program allows NM school districts and charter schools to seek reimbursement for covered services provided to Medicaid-enrolled students that

are provided through an Individualized Education Plan (IEP), Individual Family Service Plan (IFSP), a Section 504 Accommodation Plan pursuant to 34 C.F.R. 104.36, an Individual Health Care Plan, or are otherwise medically necessary as appropriate for each covered service. These Medicaid-covered services include Physician Services, Nursing Services, Psychology Services, Counseling Services, Social Work Services, Speech-Language Services, Audiology Services, Occupational Therapy, Physical Therapy, and Specialized Transportation.

There are additional services provided by school districts and charter schools that currently are outside the scope of billing for the MSBS program that are not covered in the current Medicaid state plan. Schools are not allowed to seek reimbursement from Medicaid for these services. The bill specifically identifies applied behavioral analysis and adaptive physical education; however, these are both services that are not currently included in the MSBS plan and would not be added as they are not viewed as related services under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) (Section 300.34 CFR).

The addition of charter schools in this bill does not change any requirements for the MSBS Program as charter schools are already allowed to participate.
