#### **BILL SUMMARY**

<u>Synopsis:</u> House Bill 242 clarifies the process of solemnization, licensure and contracts for marriage; provides definitions; allows appearance by remote communication technology for the issuance of a marriage license for uniformed services members who are deployed or on active duty; provides forms; provides dissolution of marriage on grounds of the marriage being void, voidable or invalid; amends fees; prescribes marriage recording and indexing guidelines; amends penalties; revises terms that describe parties to a marriage; clarifies property rights; and amends, repeals and enacts sections of chapter 40 NMSA 1978.

## FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

#### SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

In New Mexico, marriage licensing occurs in County Clerks offices and not at the Secretary of State's Office. However, the SOS understands this to be a priority of County Clerks that would aid in the administration of these licenses and ultimately in the administration of their offices as a whole.
