BILL SUMMARY

<u>Synopsis:</u> **HB 242** Is clarifying the process of solemnization, licensure, and contracts for marriage, allowing appearance by remote communication technology for the issuance of a marriage license for uniformed services members who are deployed or on active duty. It also provides forms for dissolution of marriage on grounds of the marriage being void, voidable or invalid. It amends fees prescribing marriage recording and indexing guidelines. It will amend penalties revising terms that describe parties to a marriage, clarifying property rights, amending, repealing and enacting section of Chapter 40 NMSA 1978.
