BILL SUMMARY

House Bill 273 amends the definitions as used in NMSA Chapter 5, Article 10, also known as the "Local Economic Development Act" (LEDA) to include child care facilities as a qualifying entity, also removing the out of state revenue requirement and allowing onsite delivery of services for those facilities. The bill defines a child care facility as one that is either home-based or center-based and is licensed by the Early Childhood Education and Care Department to provide care to infants, toddlers, and children.
