Synopsis:


This Bill addresses Hospitals and other organized health care providers and all affiliated, subordinate or superior health facilities to those organizations and conditions eligibility for certain legal tort caps upon compliance with a lengthy set of disclosure requirements that would detail extensive situational, financial and litigation information to the Superintendent of Insurance and for publication.


SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

Although New Mexico has a smaller number of private equity-owned hospitals (17 facilities) compared to many other states, NM has the highest proportion of private equity-backed hospitals compared to all private non-government hospitals at 43% (see map below). (https://pestakeholder.org/private-equity-hospital-tracker/#pe_map)



In a 2022 study by the <u>Petris Center</u>, researchers found when a private equity firm controlled more than 30% of the market, the prices paid by private insurers for gastroenterology and other specialties increased sharply (see graph below).

A 2023 study by <u>JAMA</u> found that, in the three years after a private equity fund bought a hospital, adverse events including surgical infections and bed sores rose by 25% among Medicare patients when compared with similar hospitals that were not bought by such investors. The researchers reported a nearly 38% increase in central line infections, a dangerous kind of infection that medical professionals say should never happen in otherwise satisfactorily performing hospitals, and a 27% increase in falls by patients while staying in the hospital.
