#### **BILL SUMMARY**

### Synopsis:

In accordance with a procedure set forth in NMSA 1978, Section 19-2-2, this joint resolution would approve retrocession of exclusive federal legislative jurisdiction with regard to a 70-acre parcel of land located near the northwestern corner of the Kirtland Air Force Base. The resolution would provide for "concurrent legislative jurisdiction," meaning (i) the parallel right of both the federal and state government to legislate; and (ii) "the vesting in the United States and the state of all the rights accorded a sovereign with the broad qualification that such authority is held concurrently over matters, including criminal laws, public powers and tax laws."

Under the statutory procedure, a federal government request to cede back to the state concurrent legislative jurisdiction is effective only if (i) the legislature approves a resolution accepting the retrocession; and (ii) the request and the resolution are recorded with the county clerk where the land is situated (here, Bernalillo County).
