**Short Title:** Ignition Interlock Task Force

**Description:** This memorial requests the formation of an ignition interlock task force to study and track whether drivers with an ignition interlock are insured at levels required during the entire time the drivers are required to us an ignition interlock device. This task force is to be formed by the Traffic Safety Bureau of the Department of Transportation and the Motor Vehicle Division (MVD) of the Taxation and Revenue Department (Tax & Rev).

The *House Judiciary Committee* amendment adds the requirement that the task force meets in a manner that is open to the public and consistent with Section 10-15-1 NMSA 1978. The task force requirement to report its findings to the legislative interim committee.

**Administrative & Compliance Impact:** This memorial would require MVD to create a report that identifies any drivers who cancelled insurance during the period their interlock license is valid. Current reports do not provide the data needed to complete the work assigned to the task force. Two pay band 75s and a pay band 90 would be required to participate in the task force.

Implementation of this memorial will have a low impact on the Information Technology Division (ITD). The estimated time to develop, test, and implement the changes is approximately 240 hours or 1.5 months for an estimated soft cost of \$13,320 for state ITD resources.
