#### **BILL SUMMARY**

Synopsis: The bill would extend the work of a task force, previously convened in 2023 by the NM Coalition of Sexual Assault Programs at the behest of the legislature, to make recommendations for policy and legislation to ensure compliance with the federal Prison Rape Elimination Act (PREA) in custodial detention in any type of correctional facility in N.M. The proposed extension is requested by the task force to complete the assigned work. Recommendations are to be conveyed to the legislative health and human services committee, the interim committee on courts, corrections, and justice, and to NM Crime Victims Reparation Commission by Nov. 1, 2024.
