SECTION III: NARRATIVE

BILL SUMMARY

<u>Synopsis</u>: This bill removes the current requirement in statute that an eligible youth must be adjudicated pursuant to the Children's Code or tribal law prior to being eligible for CYFD's Fostering Connections Program. This change expands the eligibility to include youth who were either in CYFD custody or under a voluntary placement agreement.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

There is no appropriation contained within this bill. There are no fiscal implications for CYFD. As Extended Foster Care is already in place, CYFD is able to draw down federal IV-E funds to cover costs associated with an expanded service population; and state general funds are already contained within CYFD's budget to cover any costs associated with clients who are not IV-E eligible.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

This bill furthers CYFD's mission to meet the needs of, and provide support to, all youth who age out of foster care, by adding the on average ten (10) young people per year who do not currently qualify for the Fostering Connections Program in its current form.

PERFORMANCE IMPLICATIONS

CYFD has performance measures concerning the well-being of young people which will be positively impacted by this bill.
