Synopsis:

Section 1 of SB 33 provides for a six-million-dollar (\$6,000,000) appropriation from the general fund to the children's trust fund for grant funding that can be used in FY25 and subsequent fiscal years to support programs that protect children, as outlined in Section 24-19-2 NMSA 1978.

Section 2 of SB 33 provides for a four-million-dollar (\$4,000,000) appropriation from the general fund to the next generation fund for grant funding that can be used in FY25 and subsequent fiscal years to support programs that protect children, as outlined in Section 24-19-2 NMSA 1978.

Both appropriations are non-reverting.
