BILL SUMMARY

Senate Bill 46 makes a \$25 million general fund appropriation to the Health Care Authority Department for expenditures in FY25 and beyond to fund state food banks.

Any remaining or unencumbered balances at the end of the fiscal year will not revert to the general fund. The proposed legislation does not have an effective date and will go into effect on May 15, 2024.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The fiscal impact of Senate Bill 46 is a recurring \$25 million decrease in the general fund moving afterward after FY25. Any operating budget increases are determined by the Health Care Authority Department and are not within the purview of the Department of Finance and Administration.
