BILL SUMMARY

<u>Synopsis:</u> Senate Bill 50 (SB50) is amending the Indigent Hospital and County Health Care Act to allow additional authorized uses of County Health Care Assistance Funds. This would include all or a portion of:

- Monthly premiums of health insurance policies for indigent patients.
- Out of pocket costs, including copayments and deductibles, incurred by indigent patient insureds pursuant to the terms of a health insurance policy.
