BILL SUMMARY

Synopsis:

Beginning with the 2024 fall term, a public or private post-secondary educational institution shall provide students with an educational program on hazing and the dangers of and prohibition on hazing that shall include information regarding hazing awareness, prevention, intervention and the institution's policy on hazing. The educational program may be offered in person or electronically. The institution shall incorporate the educational program as part of new student orientation sessions. The educational program shall be posted on the institution's public website for parents, legal guardians and volunteers to view.
