#### **BILL SUMMARY**

#### Synopsis:

This Bill amends the Procurement Code to:

- increase the limit for architectural or engineering services contracts with a single contractor from \$7.5M to \$15M;
- increase the limit for a single contract from \$650K to \$2M; and
- for construction contracts, increase the limit from \$12.5M to \$30M for a single contractor over three years and increases the purchase order limit \$4M to \$10M

The amendment provides an annual adjustment to the limits based on Producer Price Index (PPI).

The effective date of this bill is July 1, 2024.

## **FISCAL IMPLICATIONS**

The change could significantly reduce the administrative burden related to contracting and reduce time to execute a contract. It also could eliminate the need to perform mid-project proposals allowing for more timely completion of projects. However, the university must have a mechanism in place to ensure best available pricing. Often times, it will be necessary to require an additional solicitation to ensure best pricing. However, this change provides flexibility that could be beneficial in the course of doing business.
