BILL SUMMARY

Requires that the Secretary of the Department of Public Safety annually review the salaries of New Mexico State Police and law enforcement statewide, and if necessary, adjust New Mexico State Police salaries to ensure that members of the State Police are the highest-paid law enforcement officers in the State. Appropriates \$100,000 (GF) to the Department of Public Safety for use in FY2025 to study State Police salaries.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The Department of Public Safety conducted a salary study in FY 2019 with Kenning Consulting for \$51,000. The appropriation of \$100,000 will be sufficient to cover the cost of this expanded study, but the Department would benefit from an emergency clause with this appropriation to begin work immediately.

The Department would benefit from an emergency clause with this appropriation to begin work immediately in order to have the project completed by the ending appropriation date of June 30, 2025.
