SECTION III: NARRATIVE

BILL SUMMARY

Senate Bill 95 (SB 95) appropriates \$20 million to the Local Government Division (LGD) of the Department of Finance and Administration for expenditure in fiscal year 2024 through 2028. This appropriation is to plan, design, construct, replace and improve waterlines in Truth or Consequences (T or C) in Sierra County.

This bill has an emergency clause and would take effect immediately upon signature by the governor.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

SB 95 appropriates \$20 million from the general fund to LGD for expenditure in fiscal years 2024 through 2028. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2028 shall revert to the general fund.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

SB95 states that T or C has water line leaks that are causing the city to lose more than 20 million gallons of water or 43% of the city's total water per year.

There are very few sources of infrastructure funding that allocate large amounts of funding that T or C needs to complete these emergency repairs. Additionally, the city does not have the capacity to bond this large of an amount. However, the NM Environment Department (NMED) has stated that Truth or Consequences has received \$1.6 million from Senator Martin Heinrich to complete the design of the waterline.

PERFORMANCE IMPLICATIONS

ADMINISTRATIVE IMPLICATIONS

To distribute funding, LGD would need to enter into a grant agreement with Truth or Consequences to obligate funds and issue payment reimbursements for valid expenditures. The LGD would be tasked with ensuring the legal requirements of the grant agreement are met and that the funding is monitored throughout its life cycle.
