BILL SUMMARY

SB 135 enacts new sections of the Health Care Purchasing Act, the Public Assistance Act, the New Mexico Insurance Code, the Health Maintenance Organization Law and the Nonprofit Health Care Plan Law to establish clinical review criteria relating to step therapy for prescription drug coverage and eliminate step therapy requirements for certain conditions.
