SECTION III: NARRATIVE

BILL SUMMARY

SB153 would change the distribution amount from the early childhood education and care fund to the early education and care program fund to an amount equal to the greater of five percent of the average year-end market values of the fund for the immediately preceding three calendar years or two hundred fifty million dollars (\$250,000,000). SB153 would also provide for the reversion of unexpended and unencumbered balance from the Program Fund to the Early Childhood Education and Care Fund.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The changes made to SB153 positively impact the Early Childhood Education and Care Department (ECECD) as the bill increases the FY25 ECECF distribution to the Early Childhood Education and Care Program Fund from an estimated \$154.74 million to \$250.0 million (see Dec 2023 estimate below).

If SB153 is not enacted, the FY25 distribution to the Early Childhood Education and Care Program Fund will remain at the estimated \$154.74 million instead of \$250.0 million, a negative impact of \$95.26 million to ECECD's FY25 budget.
