BILL SUMMARY

Synopsis:

Senate Bill 267 would appropriate \$10 million from the general fund to the Department of Game and Fish in fiscal year 2025 and subsequent fiscal years to construct a native species restoration facility at Storrie Lake. Unexpended and unencumbered balances would not revert to the general fund at the end of each fiscal year.
