BILL SUMMARY

Amends the Criminal Sentencing Act to require that where a period of probation is required following a period of incarceration, the probationary period shall be served instead of any required period on parole. Time served on probation where a sentence has been deferred or suspended is limited to the maximum allowable sentence of imprisonment for the crime of which the defendant was convicted. Parole shall not be required if it would be concurrent with a period of probation ordered as part of a partially suspended sentence.
