Synopsis:

SM 4 requests the Legislative Finance Committee to conduct a study on equalizing the pension benefit structures of the Educational Retirement Board and the Public Employees Retirement Association, in collaboration with the interim committee that studies investments and pensions and the University of New Mexico Bureau of Business and Economic Research.
