SENATE BILL 271

**56TH LEGISLATURE - STATE OF NEW MEXICO - SECOND SESSION, 2024**

AN ACT

RELATING TO CRIMINAL PROCEDURE; REQUIRING THE COURT TO HOLD A  
PERSON WITHOUT BOND FOR A VIOLATION OF CONDITIONS OF RELEASE TO  
CONSIDER MODIFICATION OR REVOCATION OF THOSE CONDITIONS OF  
RELEASE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. A new section of Chapter 31, Article 3 NMSA  
1978 is enacted to read:

"[NEW MATERIAL] NO-BOND HOLD FOR VIOLATION OF CONDITIONS  
OF RELEASE.--

A. When a court receives notice that a person on  
pretrial release for a felony is arrested for a subsequent  
felony, the court shall issue an order for the person to remain  
in custody without bond.

B. The person shall remain in custody until each

5 SECTION 2. TEMPORARY PROVISION.--The supreme court shall  
6 issue rules to implement the provisions of this act.
