### AN ACT

RELATING TO GAMING; EXPANDING THE EMPLOYMENT HISTORY THAT A CANDIDATE FOR EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE GAMING CONTROL BOARD MAY HAVE; INCREASING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S POTENTIAL ANNUAL SALARY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. Section 60-2E-9 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1997, Chapter 190, Section 11, as amended) is amended to read:

"60-2E-9. EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR--EMPLOYMENT--QUALIFICATIONS.--

- The executive director shall be employed by, report directly to and serve at the pleasure of the board.
- The executive director shall have had at least five years of responsible supervisory administrative experience in a [governmental gaming] regulatory agency or gaming .226820.1

The executive director shall receive an annual C. salary to be set by the board but not to exceed [the governor of New Mexico's salary | double the maximum salary available to the governor of New Mexico."

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
