15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
16	SECTION 1. Section 4-44-4 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1957,
17	Chapter 196, Section 2, as amended) is amended to read:

C. The governing body of an H class county shall designate whether each of the offices of treasurer, assessor, sheriff and county clerk is part time or full time; however, a change in that designation shall not take effect until the first day of the term of an elected county official who takes office after the change in designation is approved."

SECTION 5. A new section of Chapter 4, Article 44 NMSA 1978 is enacted to read:

"[<u>NEW MATERIAL</u>] COUNTY SALARIES--DEPARTMENT ASSISTANCE--CONSUMER PRICE INDEX--ESCALATOR.--

A. On July 1, 2025 and on July 1 of each successive year, the salaries provided by Sections 4-44-4, 4-44-4.1, 4-44-5 and 4-44-14 NMSA 1978 shall be adjusted by multiplying the salaries provided in those sections as of July 1, 2024 by a fraction, the numerator of which is the consumer price index of the previous year and the denominator of which is the consumer price index for calendar year 2023; provided that a salary shall not be adjusted downward as a result of a decrease in the consumer price index; and provided further that an increase shall not take effect until the first day of the term of an elected or appointed county official.

the department of finance and administration shall provide
 assistance to counties in the calculation of the consumer price
 index.

C. As used in this section, "consumer price index" means the consumer price index, not seasonally adjusted, for all urban consumers, United States city average for all items or its successor index, as published by the United States department of labor for a calendar year."

SECTION 6. APPLICABILITY.--An increase in a permitted maximum salary provided by the provisions of this act shall not take effect until the first day of the term of an elected or appointed county official who takes office after the effective date of this act.
